What's in the Box

- 1x Kaico Pro NFC Emulator
- 1x USB-C Charging Cable
- 1x QR code with a link to a Quick Start Guide

Device Overview

- **1.6" OLED Display** – Bright, sharp, and easy to read in any lighting
- **Scroll Wheel** – Used for navigation and file selection
- **USB-C Port** – For charging
- **Bluetooth Connectivity** – For File Transfer
- **Internal Storage** – Holds 3,000+ NFC files
- **NFC Reader/Emulator** – Tap to scan files
- **Internal Mini Games** – Extra fun in such a small package

Getting Started

1. **Charge the Device**
Use the included USB-C cable. A full charge takes about 1–2 hours and provides weeks of standby time.
2. **Power On**
Rotate or press the **scroll wheel** once to wake the screen.
3. **Navigate Files**
 - Rotate the **scroll wheel up/down** to scroll through your NFC tag files.
 - Press the scroll wheel **inward (click)** to select and activate a tag.
4. **Use With Console**
Once a file is selected, hold the Kaico Pro NFC Scanner near the **right Joy-Con, Switch Pro Controller, or 3DS NFC reader** to emulate the tag.

Uploading New NFC/Amiibo Files

The Kaico PRO NFC Scanner works with our official upload tool via any web browser.

Here's how to add new .bin files:

Uploading via Website

1. **Go to:**
<https://pixl.amiibo.xyz/>

2. **Connect to Your Computer**

Select the language from the language drop down menu

Select Connect and use Bluetooth to connect to the Kaico Pro NFC Reader

Click the E:/ External Flash drive that appears when connected

Upload Files

- Go into the folder you wish to upload the NFC tags to (You can always click Parent Folder if you need to go back a screen)
- Select the Upload button in the top left corner
- Drag and Drop your file to the upload box or press click to upload to browse your computer for the needed file
- Double click the .bin file you wish to upload, and it will be added to the queue and immediately start transferring
- Once its shows 100% and then shows a green tick the file will have been copied over
- When you have finished sending files over simply press the x button in the top right-hand corner then confirm this by clicking yes.
- You can then press the disconnect button in the top right-hand corner to disconnect from the Kaico Pro NFC reader

You will now have all the bin files you have transferred over from the PC accessible on your Kaico Pro NFC reader and they will now be scannable by the console.
